MIEMA illustrated the Enerscapes MED project and its partnership, structure, objectives, methodology and actions. In particular, MIEMA focused on the landscape assessment methodology that has been defined to evaluate the impacts on landscapes and to define the development procedures for "RES-Landscape Action Plans" adaptable to different territorial contexts and functional for the development of local resources.

The RAEE presented the participatory process set up to introduce PV solar plants in the Natural Regional Parks of Rhone-Alpes, target area of the Enerscapes project, and the landscape evaluation assessment approach.

Lazio Region in collaboration with the <u>University of Roma3</u> presented the methodology for the development of multiple energy-landscape Scenarios for the construction of the Pontine Plain Action plan.

University of Roma3, as scientific consultant for Lazio Region, presented the Role of Landscape Assessment in the RES Introduction Process, illustrating some best practices and the Lazio Case studies.
